Your Church Can Be a Thankgiving Blessing










Pastor's Corner with Dan Kuno

Church of Hope Star Quilt Raffle



MMBB Cares!



Pastors are essential to the health of our congregations. We know our clergy need to be equipped and refreshed for their difficult work yet according to Barna Research about 42% of pastors want to quit. Over half of pastors who have considered quitting full-time ministry say "the immense stress of the job" has factored into their thoughts on leaving.

Beyond these general stressors, two in five pastors (43%) say "I feel lonely and isolated. We want our pastors to feel cared for and confident in their ministry. MMBB (Ministers and Missionaries Benefit Board) has received a grant from the Lilly Foundation to offer FREE counseling and ministry coaching to any ordained minister or a person functioning in an ordained role. This is a tremendous opportunity to receive up to 6 counseling sessions or 8 coaching sessions FREE via telehealth. You don't need to be a member of MMBB or even working in an ABC church to qualify.
